Keith was raised in a working-class neighborhood in central Allentown, Pennsylvania. He obtained his Bachelor of Science degree from Philadelphia College of Bible, currently known as Cairn University, in 1978. Subsequently, he pursued advanced academic qualifications at Grace Theological Seminary in Indiana, earning a Master of Arts in Biblical Counseling in 1984, followed by a Master of Divinity in 1986. During his time at seminary, Keith received the Student Preaching Award in 1984, recognizing his exemplary preaching skills. He had the privilege of studying under Dr. Larry Crabb, a prominent Christian psychologist and author, and later worked with him as an intern and teaching assistant. Keith's commitment to educational growth culminated in the attainment of a Doctor of Ministry from Dallas Theological Seminary in 2016.

In 1985, Keith and his family relocated to New Orleans, where he established and directed Christian Counseling Ministries. Under his leadership, the organization provided essential support to numerous individuals confronting personal and spiritual challenges, offering counseling services across multiple locations throughout the metropolitan area, supported by a team of counseling associates. Through his dedication and contributions, Keith garnered recognition as a Bible conference teacher and preacher. Additionally, he attained licensure as a professional counselor in the state of Louisiana.

In 1991, after seven years of significant service in counseling ministry, Keith was called to serve as the pastor of Faith Bible Church in Slidell, Louisiana, a position he held for two decades. In addition to his pastoral responsibilities, he also served as the Chaplain for the local fire department and functioned as a ministry consultant with Front Line Ministries. In this role, he provided instruction and support to missionaries serving in Kenya, Mexico, Central America, and Russia.

In the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina in 2005, Keith assumed leadership of the Katrina Relief Team at Faith Bible Church, coordinating recovery efforts. This initiative involved organizing thousands of volunteers from across the nation who aided hundreds of families in the greater New Orleans area, creating a significant and lasting impact on the community. In acknowledgment of their leadership and unwavering commitment, Keith and his wife, Cyndi, were honored as Alumni of the Year in 2006 by Philadelphia Biblical University, now known as Cairn University.

After serving for many years in Louisiana, Keith felt called to return to Pennsylvania in 2010 to be closer to his aging relatives. He became the senior pastor of Grace Community Church in Chalfont, where he continued his passion for preaching, teaching, discipleship, and community outreach until 2021.

In 2021, Keith joined the staff of [Interim Pastor Ministries](#), expanding his ministry to support churches in transition. In February 2022, he accepted a position as interim pastor at Petersburg Baptist Church in Petersburg, New York. He concluded his service there in August 2025, successfully facilitating the smooth transition of leadership to the church's new full-time pastor.

Keith and Cyndi have been married for 47 years and are the parents of three adult children and grandparents to five grandchildren. As Keith looks to the future, he remains passionate about supporting churches and leaders through consulting, teaching, mentoring, preaching, and discipleship.
